

**WHEREAS:** Lheidli T'enneh Band Chief and Council is doing a Traditional Use Study, the purpose of which is to map Lheidli T'enneh use of natural and cultural resources within a person's lifetime; and

**WHEREAS:** Lheidli T'enneh Chief and Council will be using the study to support land-use planning processes, decision-making and treaty negotiations; and

**WHEREAS:** Lheidli T'enneh Chief and Council strongly encourages the full support of community members and wish to address any concerns members may have regarding confidentiality and the release of information:

**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:** that the following provisions regarding confidentiality of Traditional Use Study information be adopted:

- 1) No person may look at a participant's individual overlay/(s) or listen to a participant's individual map session cassette tape(s) without that person's written permission. The only exception to this pertains to people hired by the Band Council to work on the Traditional Use Study Project.
- 2) All persons hired by the Lheidli T'enneh Chief and Council to conduct the map interviews or to put the collected information in a form it can be used, are bound by legal contract to honour strict rules of confidentiality.
- 3) The final set of maps will not have any person's name on it.
- 4) The report that goes with the maps will have peoples' names in it, but access to it will be strictly controlled by the Lheidli T'enneh Chief and Council. It will be used only for advancing Lheidli T'enneh Title, Rights, jurisdiction and interests of the Lheidli T'enneh Band.
